**RIVERSIDE WHEELMEN** Are Preparing for the Big Meet in September  
Riverside, July 27, 1899 —At a meeting of the Riverside Wheelmen league, held last evening,  
the following committees were appointed to carry out the big meet to be held here on September  
9th. The meeting also arranged the program given below:

Committee on L. A. W. \*(see below) meeting, H. S. Kennedy, J. E. Beamer and G. B. Kennedy: prize committee, G. W. Cobb, I. S. Logan, G. B. Kennedy; finance committee, W. A. Correll, J. A. Simms, H. S. Kennedy; track committee, G. B. Cox, Carson Shoemaker, H. E. Scott, Ray Rothrock, Frank Boughn: parade committee, J. L. Campbell, H. Haskell, Will Brundige: executive committee, W. A. Correll, G. B. Kennedy, J. A. Simms, I. S. Logan and H. S. Kennedy.

Racing program: One mile novice, half mile division, championship; one mile division championship; two-mile handicap; two thirds mile for boys under 16 years; exhibition trick riding by Trilby Fowler; twenty-five mile team race.

Arrangements were made to entertain the visiting wheelmen and delegates to the division meet on September 8th by giving runs to the various points of Interest about the valley and city.

It is expected that at least three teams will enter for the twenty-five mile race, namely; Riverside, Los Angeles and Santa Ana. The riders to compose the Riverside team are Carson Shoemaker, Geo. B. Cox and H. E. Scott. These are the same boys who won the cup at Los Angeles some years ago. The cup is now held by the Santa Ana team.
